HOST AGENCY CHECKLIST FOR NASRO STAR TRAINING

Use this checklist to confirm your facility can support the training course.

CLASSROOM REQUIREMENTS

- Seating with tables for **up to 25 students**
- Classroom located **near training area**

Audio / Visual

- LCD projector **or** large monitor
- Projection screen
- Speakers compatible with laptop audio
- HDMI connection access
- Extension cords and power strips
- AV table or cart
- IT support available if needed

TRAINING STRUCTURE (Movement / Force-on-Force)

Structure Type

- Commercial building, office building, or school
- Wing of school or building **separated from public traffic**



Minimum Layout

- Multiple rooms
- Hallways for movement
- Corner-fed or center-fed rooms
- Multiple floors (**preferred**)
- Stairways (**optional but beneficial**)

Training Conditions

- Structure closed to general public during training
- Building marked “**Police Training**”
- Areas approved for **Airsoft and Simunitions®**

Movement Areas

- Ability to move **between buildings or structures**
- Outdoor movement space (e.g., building to parking lot)
- Movement areas ideally **out of view from the public**

Vehicles

- Two (2) police vehicles** available for training scenarios

Portable Targets

- 4 portable target stands**
- 12 paper range targets**
- Staples, spray glue, or clips for mounting targets

Force-on-Force Support

- 3–4 role players** available for **Day 3 scenarios**
- Designated areas approved for **Simunitions® or Airsoft**



CLEANING SUPPLIES

- Paper towels
- Trash bags
- Broom
- Dustpan
- Access to **warm soapy water**

SAFETY & MEDICAL

- Trauma bag / medical kit available each day
- Medical plan confirmed at start of training
- Optional **armed officer (“Guardian Angel”)** for external security

ON-SITE HOST COORDINATION

- Daily **Point of Contact (POC)** available
- Radio communication available
- Access to **building keys or access cards**
